Building Knowledge for Environmental Action

- Twinleaf Arakan conducted a series of Environmental Awareness Trainings aimed at strengthening rural youth's understanding of environmental conservation, biodiversity and the sustainable use of natural resources such as forest, soil, and freshwater. The training also explored the science behind climate change, its local impacts, and the crucial role of youth leadership in community-based environmental solutions. A total of 62 rural youths from 10 villages took part in the sessions.



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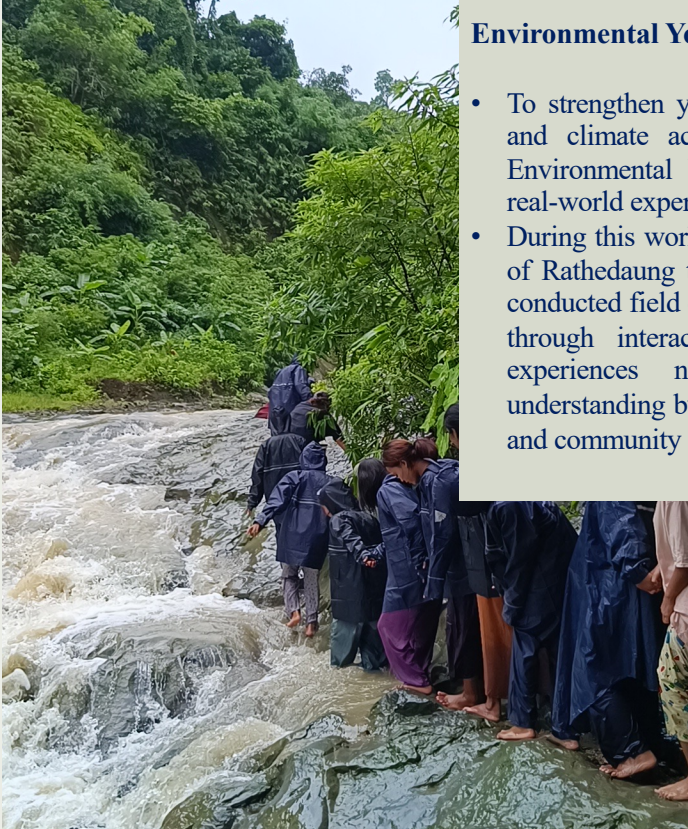
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Environmental Youth-Driven Workcamp

- To strengthen youth engagement in environmental protection and climate action, Twinleaf Arakan Team organized an Environmental Youth-Driven Workcamp, giving participants real-world experiences that turned knowledge into action.
- During this workcamp, 20 young participants from 10 villages of Rathedaung township engaged directly with local farmers, conducted field explorations in nearby forest areas, and learned through interactive team-based activities. These hand-on experiences not only deepened their environmental understanding but also encouraged teamwork, problem-solving and community collaboration.
